Method to Madness

- My idea behind this type of reading log is three fold.
 - o 1. Keep track of the books that students are reading and the time they are reading each day.
 - 2. Practice a skill based on reading, writing, and science standards as well as return to previous standards to add more practice.
 - 3. To give students an opportunity to interact more with their parents and siblings, through instilling a little more patriotism, awareness of national events and ideas, and learn a little bit of charity and acts of kindness to others.
- At the top of each week's reading log is an event that is going on throughout the country. As part of my rewards system,
 I pass out tokens. Students will get an extra token if parents check and sign that their students performed each action
 suggested. This is an option and not required.
