



How Beans Begin to Grow

An experiment in growing beans.

Instructions

1. Find a partner or two.
2. Gather your materials.
 - a. One sheet of paper towel.
 - b. One pinto bean seed.
 - c. A Ziplock Bag.
3. Using a marker, write your and your partner's names at the top of both Ziploc bags.
4. Fold your paper towel so that it can fit easily into the Ziploc bag.
5. Using a spray bottle dampen the paper towel.
6. Place a bean seed on top of the wet paper towel.
7. Seal the Ziploc bag shut.
8. Place one Ziploc bag in the window seal.
9. Place the other Ziploc bag in the empty cupboard.
10. Over the next week, fill out the data observation table.
11. Make sure to fill out day one today.
