1  **A: MAMMAL**
C: An animal that has hair, breathes air, and feeds its young with milk.

2  **A: VERTEBRATE**
C: An animal that has a backbone or spinal column.

3  **A: WARM-BLOODED**
C: An animal that can maintain a constant body temperature regardless of its surroundings.

4  **A: ENDOTHERMIC**
C: The scientific term for being warm-blooded.

5  **A: HAIR**
C: A characteristic covering found on the skin of all mammals at some point in their lives.

6  **A: FUR**
C: Thick, soft hair that covers the bodies of many mammals for warmth.

7  **A: MILK**
C: The nutrient-rich liquid that mother mammals produce to feed their young.

8  **A: LUNGS**
C: The organs used by mammals to breathe air.

9  **A: DIAPHRAGM**
C: A large muscle at the bottom of the chest that helps mammals breathe.

10  **A: MONOTREMES**
C: A rare group of mammals that lay eggs instead of giving birth to live young.

11  **A: MARSUPIALS**
C: Mammals that give birth to underdeveloped young which then grow in a pouch.

12  **A: PLACENTALS**
C: Mammals whose young develop fully inside the mother's body before birth.

13  **A: PLATYPUS**
C: An egg-laying mammal with a bill like a duck and a tail like a beaver.

14  **A: ECHIDNA**
C: A spiny, egg-laying mammal also known as a spiny anteater.

15  **A: KANGAROO**
C: A famous Australian marsupial that jumps on its powerful back legs.

16  **A: POUCH**
C: A pocket of skin on a marsupial's body where the baby stays to grow.

17  **A: KOALA**
C: An Australian marsupial that lives in trees and eats eucalyptus leaves.

18  **A: OPOSSUM**
C: The only marsupial found in North America.

19  **A: WHALE**
C: A large marine mammal that lives in the ocean but breathes air through a blowhole.

20  **A: DOLPHIN**
C: An intelligent aquatic mammal known for its playful behavior and use of sonar.

21  **A: BAT**
C: The only mammal capable of true, flapping flight.

22  **A: PRIMATE**
C: A group of mammals that includes monkeys, apes, and humans.

23  **A: RODENT**
C: A type of mammal with front teeth that never stop growing, like a mouse or squirrel.

24  **A: CARNIVORE**
C: A mammal that primarily eats meat.

25  **A: HERBIVORE**
C: A mammal that primarily eats plants.

26  **A: OMNIVORE**
C: A mammal that eats both plants and animals.

27  **A: HIBERNATION**
C: A deep sleep some mammals enter during winter to save energy.

28  **A: MIGRATION**
C: When mammals travel long distances to find food or better weather.

29  **A: BLUBBER**
C: A thick layer of fat under the skin of marine mammals to keep them warm.
